

Notice of Alamance County Early Voting Site and Buffer Zones

The following is the location of Alamance County early voting site and a description of the buffer zone concerning 2025 electioneering. Buffer zones are set as designated by G.S. 163-166.4. Election officials will mark buffer zones “**No Campaigning**” signs.

Campaigners are not to enter the buffer zone except for specific business with the Board of Elections office or for voting purposes. Please note public restroom facilities are not available at the early voting site.

While inside the buffer zone for one of the aforementioned reasons, campaigners should refrain from engaging in activities that violate or appear to violate campaigning guidelines. Campaigning issues or suspected violations are to be brought to the attention of the Chief Judge of the early voting site and to the Director at the Board of Elections office.

Each early voting site has a designated campaigning area as described below. Campaigners should never block traffic, parking, or entrances. Campaign supplies should not be left unattended and may not be left at the site overnight.

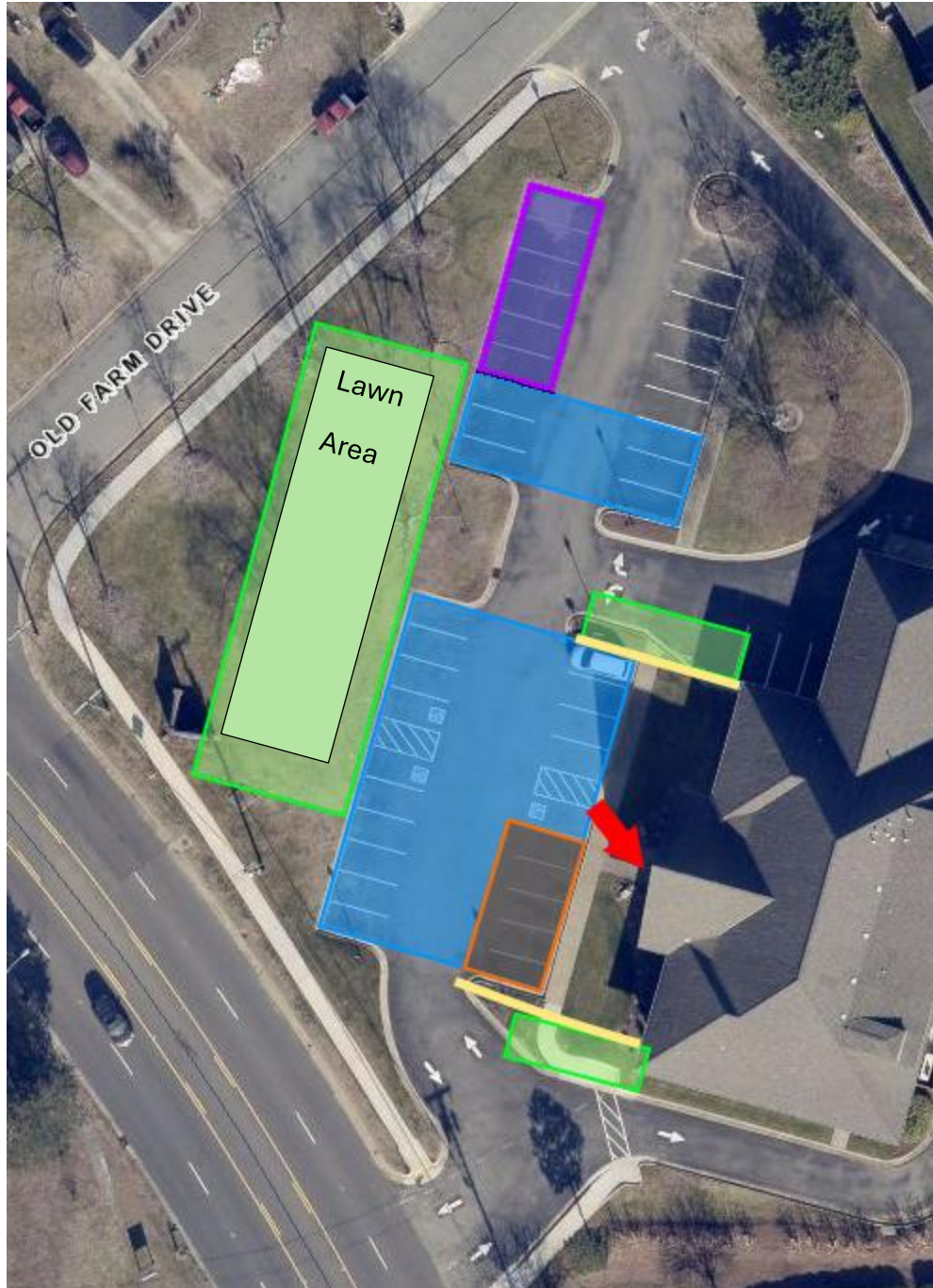
Buffer Zone: 50 ft from entrance.

Campaigning area: Outside the light fixtures to the left and right of the entrance and in the lawn area.

Tents: No tents are allowed in the campaigning area next to the building, lawn area only.

Signage: Will not be allowed in any medians or landscaped areas next to the building.
