Board of Elections to Conduct Pre-Election Testing of Voting Machines

Graham, NC – The Alamance County Board of Elections will be conducting Logic & Accuracy testing starting September 16, 2026 until completion. The testing process is open for public observation only by appointment due to space restrictions. County Boards of Elections are required by state law to conduct a pre-election test, also known as Logic and Accuracy (L&A), of all voting equipment to be used in each election. L&A testing is a collection of pre-election procedures that ensure the voting system to be used in an upcoming election can properly display ballot choices, collect votes, and tabulate results.

During the testing process, ballots marked with a pre-determined pattern will be scanned through **every tabulator** that will be used in the November 3, 2026 General Election. Results data collected from tabulators should result in the pre-determined vote pattern, indicating the accuracy and readiness of the voting equipment. The ExpressVote ballot marking device is also tested for accuracy and readiness. Only voting equipment that meets the pre-election testing standards will be deployed for use at the polling places.
